Dear Mr. Borchick:

This refers to your application dated May 27, 2015, for renewal of your NRC license. The application also included a change in your mailing address.

Please note that the first two digits of an NRC license identify the State of the licensee's mailing address. Therefore, when a licensee changes its mailing address from one State to another, a new license with a new number (corresponding to the State of the new mailing address) must be issued to replace the existing license. Your mailing address had been in the State of West Virginia, and your renewal application has the mailing address in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, therefore it became necessary to administratively terminate your license No. 47-25325-01, and concurrently issue a new license No. 37-35255-01, with mailing address in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Enclosed with this letter are the new and the terminated licenses. Please review the enclosed documents carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region I Office, Licensing Assistance Team, (610) 337-5239, so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

The NRC expects licensees to conduct their programs with meticulous attention to detail and high standards of safety and compliance. Serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, therefore you must conduct your program according to NRC regulations, the conditions of your NRC license, and the representations made in your application.

You will be periodically inspected by the NRC. Failure to conduct your program safely and in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and the representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14).
