DBA NIXON REQUEST FOR WITHHOLDING INFORMATION FROM PUBLIC  
DISCLOSURE

Dear Mr. King:

Triple, Inc. DBA Nixon submitted an affidavit dated May 7, 2015, executed by Patricia Tipton, requesting that the information contained in the Quality Assurance documents in Attachment H and I, submitted in connection with your application dated May 8, 2015, for the watch Model Night Ranger be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.390.

The affidavit stated that the submitted information should be considered exempt from mandatory public disclosure because (1) the information contained in the documents is proprietary, (2) the information contain details on the assembly and processes associated with products distribution, and could cause substantial harm if revealed to competitors, and (3) the information was sent to NRC in confidence and is unavailable in any other public document.

We have reviewed your application and the material in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.390 and, on the basis of your statements, have determined that the submitted information sought to be withheld contains proprietary and commercial confidential information and should be withheld from public disclosure.

Therefore, Triple, Inc. DBA Nixon QA documents included in your application dated May 8, 2015, will be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.390(a)(4) and Section 103(b) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended. Withholding from public inspection shall not affect the right, if any, of persons properly and directly concerned to inspect the documents.

If the basis for withholding this information from public inspection should change in the future such that the information could then be made available for public inspection, you should promptly notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). You also should understand that the NRC may have cause to review this determination in the future, for example, if the
