The requirement to submit the information was previously approved, but the forms themselves were never previously reviewed and approved. The forms include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• NRC Form 890, "Single Positive Test Form;"</li> <li>• NRC Form 891, "Annual Reporting Form for Drug and Alcohol Tests;" and</li> <li>• NRC Form 892, "Annual Fatigue Reporting Form."</li> </ul> <p>The e-forms facilitate consistency and accuracy through the use of a fill-in-the-blank format and drop-down menus. The forms provide a voluntary alternative means of reporting information required under 26.717 for drug and alcohol tests and 26.203(e) for fatigue and work hour controls. Licensees may still report this information in any format they choose; however, the forms provide a more efficient and standardized way of reporting should licensees choose to use them.</p> <p>This renewal for this collection was submitted to OMB on 7/29/14 and approved on 11/13/14.</p>
	Nuclear Regulatory Commission	3150-0226	Request for Information Related to the Filtering Strategies and Severe Accident Management of Boiling Water Reactors (BWR) with Mark I and Mark II Containments Rulemaking	4/30/2018		<p>The NRC requested the information from the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) in a letter dated May 21, 2014 prior to obtaining OMB approval. To respond to this letter, NEI obtained information from 30 Boiling Water Reactors. The information was collected for the Filtering Strategies and Severe Accident Management of BWR with Mark I and Mark II Containment rulemaking (filtering strategies rulemaking). The NRC requested detailed cost estimates of alternatives, general assumptions from proprietary documents being made public and plant-specific information on BWR with Mark I and Mark II containments. This one-time collection added 713.3 hours of annual burden to NEI and 30 BWR licensees.</p> <p>This new collection was submitted to OMB on 12/1/14 and approved on 4/14/15.</p>
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
