SUBJECT: ADDITIONAL OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS
TO LOW-LEVEL RADIOACTIVE WASTE DISPOSAL REGULATIONS, 10 CFR
PARTS 20 AND 61 (RIN 3150-AI92) (NRC-2011-0012)

Dear Chairman Howell:

As noted in my June 19, 2015, letter, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is proposing to amend Parts 20 and 61 of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) which establishes the licensing requirements for land disposal of low-level radioactive waste (LLW). The proposed amendments would require LLW waste disposal licensees and license applicants to prepare revised and new site-specific technical analyses. The new requirements would ensure that LLW streams that are significantly different from the LLW streams considered in the current 10 CFR Part 61 regulatory basis can also be disposed of safely and meet the performance objectives in the regulations. The amended regulations would also allow the development of site-specific criteria for the acceptance of LLW based on the result of the technical analyses. Finally, the proposed amendments would better align the requirements with current health and safety standards. You are receiving this letter because your Tribe's Reservation land is near one of the four operating low-level waste sites that will be affected by this rule.

The proposed rule was originally published in the *Federal Register* (80 FR 16082) on March 26, 2015 and the comment period closed on July 24, 2015. However, the comment period was reopened with an August 27, 2015, *Federal Register* notice (80 FR 51964). Comments for both the proposed rule and the conforming guidance documents should be submitted by **September 21, 2015**. Comments received after this date will be considered if it is practical to do so, but the NRC is able to ensure consideration only for comments received on or before September 21, 2015.
