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AUDIT OF NRC'S REGULATORY ANALYSIS PROCESS

Status of Recommendations

Recommendation 1:

Develop and implement a formal training/qualification program for cost estimators. The training/qualification program can be incorporated into the office instructions and procedures of the NRC offices with regulatory analysis responsibilities.

Agency Response Dated July 23, 2015:

Agree. The NRC is committed to continually improving the skill of its cost estimators and will formalize its existing regulatory analysis training/qualification program. The NRC will incorporate this program into office instructions and procedures in accordance with agency processes. Toward that end, the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation (NRR) is working in collaboration with the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards and the Office of New Reactors to establish and formalize this agency program.

Target Completion Date: December 2016

OIG Analysis:

The proposed corrective action addresses the intent of OIG's recommendation. This recommendation will be closed when OIG receives and reviews documentation that the agency has developed and implemented a formal

training/qualification program for cost estimators.

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Status of Recommendations

Recommendation 2:

Implement established knowledge management techniques for the regulatory analysis program.

Agency Response Dated July 23, 2015:

Agree. The NRC is currently creating a new cost-benefit guidance document. The new document will replace and expand upon the following NUREGs:

- NUREG/BR-0058, "Regulatory Analysis Guidelines of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission;"
- NUREG/BR-0184, "Regulatory Analysis Technical Evaluation Handbook;" and
- NUREG-1409, "Backfitting Guidelines."

This new guidance document will establish a single integrated framework to ensure efficient and effective implementation of the NRC's regulatory analysis program. Toward that end, this guidance document will set forth the policy, processes, methodologies, and guidance for regulatory analysis and cost estimating and will incorporate relevant cost estimating best practices, as applicable.

Target Completion Date: February 2017

OIG Analysis:

The proposed corrective action partly addresses the intent of OIG's recommendation. OIG acknowledges the benefits of documenting guidance. However, this recommendation will be closed when OIG receives and reviews documentation that NRR implemented established knowledge management techniques for the regulatory analysis program such as: (1) development of succession plans to help address NRR's need to replace, on a timely basis, competent personnel over the long term; (2) where possible, recapture knowledge from former employees; and (3) development of a mentoring program to capture and transfer key knowledge.

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Status of Recommendations

Recommendation 3: Update and implement the cost benefit guidance documents

as planned in SECY-14-0002. Incorporate this guidance into

office procedures by reference.

Agency Response

Dated July 23, 2015: Agree. The NRC is currently updating these guidance

documents as discussed in the response to

Recommendation 2 and will incorporate this guidance into

applicable office procedures by reference.

Target Completion Date: February 2017

OIG Analysis: The proposed corrective action addresses the intent of OIG's

recommendation. This recommendation will be closed when OIG receives and reviews the updated cost benefit guidance documents. NRC must also provide proof for OIG's review,

that the guidance documents are implemented and incorporated into office procedures by reference.

Agency Response

Dated August 17, 2015: Agree. The NRC is committed to enhance public

developing a new policy statement on NRC public meetings, as well as updating associated guidance. The NRC will incorporate this recommendation into the appropriate policy

and guidance in accordance with agency processes.
