Dear Mr. McCann:

This refers to an investigation conducted by the NRC's Office of Investigations regarding activities at Arkansas Nuclear One. The Office of Investigations initiated the investigation to determine whether employees at Entergy Operations, Inc.'s Arkansas Nuclear One, Russellville, Arkansas, willfully failed to correct the violation for updating the Safety Analysis Report for onsite storage of solid radioactive waste.

Based on the evidence developed during the investigation, the allegation that employees at Arkansas Nuclear One willfully failed to correct the violation for updating the Safety Analysis Report for onsite storage of solid radioactive waste was not substantiated. The NRC plans no further action related to the willful aspect of this allegation and considers this investigation closed.
