This refers to U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) License Number 19-31447-01, Docket No. 03038471, Control No. 585379, to our letter dated April 22, 2015, and to our August 12, 2015 telephone conversation between Messrs. Craig S. Goldberg, Barry J. Silber, Michael S. Gray and Megan Y. Frailer of our staff, and Ms. Elizabeth Ullrich of your Commission.

We are hereby requesting the aforesaid NRC license be amended to include the storage of all radioactive material/commodities authorized under this license as a principal activity in addition to those principal activities currently authorized. This is necessary due to the nature and conduct of official military operations for contingency or emergency purposes as well as assuring total life cycle responsibilities in order to meet mission requirements. The material under these conditions will be afforded the same controls (security, accountability, etc.) throughout its life cycle. There will be no increased risk to the safety and health of members of the public due to granting of this request.

Approval of the above request will negate our need to extend the time periods established in 10 CFR 30.36(d) and 10 CFR 30.36(f) as requested in our letter of 22 April 2015.
