

By a June 27, 1985 letter the State of South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control granted approval for such a disposition.

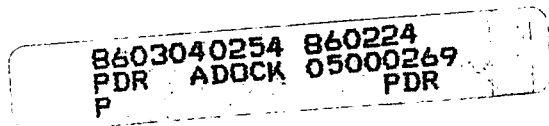
