
Dear Mr. Denton:

By a letter dated May 2, 1986 the NRC staff provided a status report of approved regulatory improvements for Oconee Nuclear Station for Duke's review and comments. The staff requested a response in the form of a marked up listing by May 31, 1986 verifying the completion/implementation of each item along with projections for items presently not fully implemented.

Duke Power Company is unable to provide a response by the requested date due to 1) the large number of items on the Regulatory Information Tracking System list covering broad areas of all Oconee units, 2) the impact of the currently ongoing Safety Systems Functional Inspection at Oconee on the available manpower and, 3) the involvement of the personnel in activities in support of other regulatory commitments.

Duke Power Company anticipates to complete its review of the referenced list and provide a response by August 1, 1986.
