Generic Letter 83-28, Item 2.1 (Part 2), required all licensees to confirm that they have established an interface with either the nuclear steam system supplier or with the vendors of each of the components of their reactor trip system. This interface program should include: (1) periodic communication between the licensee and the vendor, and (2) a system of positive feedback which confirms receipt by the licensee of transmittals with technical information.

We have enclosed our safety evaluation and our consultant's report, EG&G-NTA-7765. We find your responses acceptable and therefore, consider Item 2.1 (Part 2) to be complete. Item 2.1, Part 1, equipment classification was found acceptable by our September 28, 1987 letter.
