Dear Mr. Tarver:

This responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) appeal dated May 19, 2015, and received by this office on June 3, 2015. This appeal is related to FOIA 2015-0210 in which you requested copies of interagency agreements and memoranda of understanding and functionally equivalent documents between the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC) and the Defense Contract Audit Agency "from 2010 to current." The NRC Office of the Inspector General (OIG) withheld requested information under the authority of Exemption (b) (6) of the FOIA, because the disclosure would result in a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. You appeal denial of the requested records objecting to the "large number of redactions" and request review and "to have a large amount overturned."

Acting on your appeal, I have reviewed this matter, and have determined that the NRC OIG must continue to withhold the information. Therefore, your appeal is denied.

The NRC OIG will continue to withhold the redacted information pursuant to Exemption (b) (6) of the FOIA. Specifically, I have concluded that disclosure of the information you requested, which includes personal identifiers, would constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

This is a final agency decision with regard to these documents. As set forth in 5 U.S.C. 552 (a)(4)(b), judicial review of this decision is available in a District Court of the United States in the district in which you reside, in which you have a principal place of business, or in the District of Columbia.
