The United States Environmental Protection Agency is requesting the amendment of its NRC license (34-12736-02) for our facilities located in Cincinnati, Ohio. We request the removal of radium 226/228 and Chris Impellitteri as an Authorized User. The US EPA included this isotope in anticipation of its use in drinking water studies. However, these studies were not pursued and at no time did EPA Cincinnati possess any radium 226/228 material.

All other license conditions would remain the same.
