Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc. (ENO) is providing notification to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) of Palisades Nuclear Plant's (PNP) intent to utilize American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) Code Case N-716-1, *Alternative Classification and Examination Requirements, Section XI, Division 1*, for the current third period of the fourth 10-year Inservice Inspection Interval.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.55a(a)(3)(ii), as conditioned by 10 CFR 50.55a(b)(5), ASME Code Case N-716-1 is acceptable for use without prior NRC approval by reference in Section C, *Staff Regulatory Guidance, Table 1, Acceptable Section XI Code Cases*, of NRC Regulatory Guide (RG) 1.147, *Inservice Inspection Code Case Acceptability, ASME Section XI, Division 1*, Revision 17 (Reference 1), as noticed in the Federal Register (79 FR 65776) on November 5, 2014.
