SUBJECT: U.S. NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION ACTION IN  
RESPONSE TO THE AUGUST 12, 2015, MEETING OF THE  
ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON THE MEDICAL USES OF  
ISOTOPES

Below is the recommendation from the August 12, 2015, teleconference meeting of the Advisory Committee on the Medical Uses of Isotopes (ACMUI). Following the recommendation is the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff response and/or position.

**ITEM (1):** The Committee endorsed the Germanium-68 Decommissioning Funding Plan Subcommittee Report and its addendum. This included a recommendation to add a footnote to the Title 10 *Code of Federal Regulations* Part 30, Appendix B, "Quantities of Licensed Material Requiring Labeling" to state the following:

*<sup>3</sup>This does not include Ge-68 in a Ge-68/Ga-68 medical use generator (limit less than 10 uCi x 10<sup>5</sup>) that is returned to the manufacturer at end of use.*

The recommendation passed unanimously with 12 favorable votes. The NRC staff will review and analyze the recommendation in the report. Staff will make a determination about the most effective and efficient way to address the Germanium-68 decommissioning funding plan issue and report to the ACMUI at the October meeting.
