ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUESTED:

To remove each of the licensee's 3844 Lindbergh Blvd. and the 450 N. New Ballas Rd. facilities from the above referenced license:

1. For each location, please list all radionuclides used or stored.
2. For each location, please provide the last date on which each radionuclide was used or stored at the facility.
3. For each location, for each radionuclide used at that location, provide final disposition including the date(s) and method(s) of final disposal. If disposal was via transfer to an authorized waste processor or another NRC or Agreement State licensee, provide the NRC license number of the authorized recipient or a copy of the Agreement State license authorizing the receipt of transferred materials. Also provide final waste manifest and/or letter from recipient licensee confirming receipt of transferred materials. Please note that bills of lading, shipment manifests and shipping papers do not usually contain sufficient information to demonstrate that materials have been safely received by an appropriately licensed entity. They typically indicate that materials were prepared for shipment or transfer only, not that they were received and accepted into the recipient's inventory under its license.

4. For each sealed source used or stored at each location of use, provide final leak test results, and describe any history of leaking sources at this facility. If no leaking sealed sources were used or stored at either of these facilities, please confirm the same.
5. For areas where radioactive materials were used or stored at each facility, please resubmit one copy of each facility diagram describing the entire location of use, including the notations identifying each location where a survey was taken. If necessary, where the full diagram is too expansive to show individual survey locations – as in the 450 N. New Ballas Rd. location - it is acceptable to submit expanded diagrams as included with the original request.
6. For each area of use at these location (e.g. - camera room, hot lab, injection room, and treadmill room at 3844 Lindbergh Blvd. and PET room, Ge-68 room, camera rooms 1 & 2, hot lab, and treadmill rooms 1 & 2 at 450 N. New Ballas Rd.), please resubmit closeout survey results, including the actual measured background reading (in cpm/100 cm²) and the raw measurements (prior to adjustment for background) for each identified survey location.
7. Please provide the name of each individual(s) who completed the closeout surveys, final disposal/transfer of radioactive materials, and/or performed leak tests for transferred sealed sources.
8. For items referred to as "equipment" and relocated to a new site from the locations to be removed from the license, please provide a description of each such item, the originating area of use, and the date(s) on which such equipment was transferred from the 3844 Lindbergh Blvd. and 450 N. New Ballas Rd. locations of use.
