Power Resources, Inc. d/b/a Cameco Resources (Cameco) is providing a request for an extension for the response time for the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) letter dated August 7, 2015, received on August 13, 2015. In this correspondence the NRC requested additional information concerning the airborne effluent and environmental monitoring program for the uranium facilities covered under License SUA-1548. Cameco will need additional time to prepare a response to this request. Crow Butte has diligently attempted to satisfy these same questions and yet acceptance by the NRC has eluded them.

The Wyoming projects are larger and to some extent more complex than those in Nebraska and it will require more time for Cameco to address the concerns raised in the August 7, 2015 letter. Cameco requests a 60 day extension to the response time for these RAIs.
