It has come to our attention that there were a few typographical errors in Amendment No. 49 of NRC License No. 13-01631-05, specifically that 'Palladium' was spelled incorrectly. In addition, we have removed License Condition 13 from Amendment 48 because it was not applicable to your program. A corrected copy of your license is enclosed. We apologize for any inconvenience this oversight may have caused you.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.


