On August 17, 2015, Geotechnology, Inc. (Geotechnology) acquired the substantial assets of Thelen Associates, Inc. (Thelen Associates) with offices located in Erlanger, Kentucky; Lexington, Kentucky; Cincinnati, Ohio; and Dayton, Ohio. As part of this asset acquisition, nuclear density gauges were transferred to Geotechnology. Several of these units, and the field representatives who operate these gauges, will continue to be located at the Lexington, Kentucky office. The current radioactive material license number associated with the Lexington, Kentucky office is 16-31460-01. As part of the acquisition, Thelen Associates and Geotechnology agreed to transfer control of the licensed material to Geotechnology.

The following statements address specific information regarding the change of ownership:

1. The new name of the licensed organization is Geotechnology, Inc.
2. The licensee contact and RSO will remain Mr. Keith Pryse. Mr. Pryse can be reached at 859-746-9400.
3. Geotechnology acquired the substantial assets (including all radioactive materials included in the license) as part of the acquisition. There was no transfer of stock as part of this acquisition. All previous Thelen Associates employees are now Geotechnology employees.
4. Changes in organization (other than corporate oversight), location, facilities, equipment and procedures are not planned with this acquisition.
5. Changes in the use, possession, location and storage of the licensed material are not planned.
6. Geotechnology is committed to abide by the constraints, conditions, requirements, representations and commitments identified on Thelen Associates' existing license.


