Enclosed is a copy of the revisions to the proposed Arizona Radiological Health Rules published in the Arizona Administration Code, Title 12, Chapter 1. The proposed revisions will be made available for public comment on October 9, 2015 with a request for comments by November 17, 2015. We request NRC's comments by November 16, 2015 in order to include them as a portion of the hearing consideration. This rulemaking package amends and adds several rules as required by RATS ID numbers 1993-1, 1995-2, 2011-1, 2011-2, 2012-1, 2012-2, 2012-3, 2012-4, and 2013-1 in order to meet federal equivalency of the radioactive materials compliance program (RAM) conducted in Arizona by the Arizona Radiation Regulatory Agency. The RATS ID worksheets are attached and part of this letter in order to identify specific corresponding Arizona rule amendments which contains underlined new language and strikethrough removal of existing language.

We believe that adoption of these revisions satisfies the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards (NMSS) Procedure SA-200.
