Esteemed Commissioners:

The linear no-threshold (LNT) standard must not be replaced with any other theory about supposed benefits of radiation exposure. Such a replacement would endanger public health.

As a safeguard to sustain public health, the NRC must strengthen all protective measures and safety measures. In order to contain the further releases of radiation, all clean-up regulations and containment regulations must be strengthened. However, this paragraph must not be construed as an approval of plans to transport waste to a single repository or multiple repositories as that would increase the risk of radiation exposure.

If the NRC decides to adopt a theory of radiological benefits to health, in gross opposition to the vast consensus of radiation scientists, then the U.S. public will undoubtedly expect the NRC commissioners to be the first to move themselves and their families into any newly-reduced exclusion zone.
