Dear Larry,

We are continuing our review of your renewal application dated April 10, 2015.

Please be aware that upon your request, proprietary information submitted to the NRC may be withheld from public disclosure. To do this, you must follow the procedures in 10 CFR 2.390(b) including requesting withholding at the time the information is submitted and complying with the document marking and affidavit requirements set forth in 10 CFR 2.390 (b)(1).

We note that in your application dated April 10, 2015, you wrote, "None of the information submitted is considered by Thermo Fisher Scientific, Inc. Environmental Instruments Division to be proprietary." However, we also note that a drawing with your SSD registration certificate NR-1234-D-101E and a drop test are both described as "Proprietary." It is also possible that other information that you have provided is marked, "Proprietary." We inform you that you must follow the procedures in 10 CFR 2.390(b) if you wish to have any of the information submitted to the NRC withheld from public disclosure.
