Please confirm receipt of this communication.

This is in reference to your letter dated May 26, 2015 requesting to amend Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 10-06493-02. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. Please provide a list of the sealed sources that were maintained at this location. Provide a copy of the last leak test performed on the sources and the calibration information for the counting equipment used to analyze the leak tests. Lastly, provide information with regard to where the sources were transferred. If the sources were transferred to another licensee, please provide documentation of the licensee's receipt of the sources, including their license number.
2. Please confirm that only materials with a half-life of less than 120 days were used at this licensed location, other than the above mentioned sealed sources.
3. Provide information regarding the disposition of any remaining waste materials.
4. Provide the date of the last use of licensed material at this location.

If we do not receive a reply from you within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your application.
