Mr. Torres:

Please find the response to your September 21, 2015 letter, mail control number 586336.

1. PacifiCorp was acquired by MidAmerican Energy Holdings Company in 2006. In 2014, MidAmerican changed its name to Berkshire Hathaway Energy. Today, PacifiCorp consists of three business units, aggregating up to PacifiCorp: Rocky Mountain Power, which delivers electricity to customers in Utah, Wyoming and Idaho.

The company legal name is "PacifiCorp, Rocky Mountain Power, Jim Bridger Power Plant." No change of ownership has occurred.

2. "Proposed Authorized Users – Before using licensed materials, authorized users will have successfully completed the training described in Criteria in the section entitled Authorized Users, in NUREG-1556, Vol. 4, dated October 1998."
3. "Surveys pursuant to 10 CFR 20.1501 will be performed by a person specifically authorized by the NRC or an Agreement State to perform these surveys."
4. "We will perform a prospective evaluation demonstrating that unmonitored individuals are not likely to receive, in one year, a radiation dose in excess of 10% of the allowable limits in 10 CFR Part 20 or we will provide dosimetry that meets the Criteria in the section entitled Radiation Safety Program – Occupational Dosimetry, in NUREG-1556, Vol. 4. Dated October 1998."
5. "Leak tests will be performed at intervals approved by the NRC or an Agreement State and specified in the SSD Registration Certificate. Leak tests will be performed by an organization authorized by the NRC or an Agreement State to provide leak testing services for other licensees or using a leak test kit supplied by an organization authorized by the NRC or an Agreement State to provide leak test kits to other licensees and

according to the kit supplier's instructions. Records of leak test results will be maintained."

6. "Routine Maintenance -- We will implement and maintain procedures for routine maintenance of our gauges according to each manufacturer's or distributor's written recommendations and instructions."
7. "Non-Routine Operations -- The gauge manufacturer, distributor or other person authorized by NRC or an Agreement State will perform non-routine operations such as installation, initial radiation survey, repair, and maintenance of components related to the radiological safety of the gauge, gauge relocation, replacement, and disposal of sealed sources, alignment, or removal of a gauge from service."
