Dear Mr. Shockey:

This refers to your application dated July 29, 2015, requesting to change your mailing address from an address in the State of Texas to an address in the State of West Virginia.

Please note that the first two digits of an NRC license identify the State of the licensee's mailing address. Therefore when a licensee changes its mailing address from one State to another, it becomes necessary to administratively terminate the existing license and concurrently issue a new license corresponding to the State of the new mailing address. You requested to change your mailing address from the State of Texas to an address in the State of West Virginia, therefore your license No. 42-35152-01 is terminated and a new license No. 47-35267-01 with mailing address in the State of West Virginia is being issued concurrently. The terms and conditions of your new license, including the expiration date, and your commitments remain unchanged and are incorporated into the new license. In accordance with your request we have also removed authorization for strontium 90 from the new license. You are required to maintain all records of disposition of this item for our review during a future NRC inspection. The terminated and the new licenses are enclosed.

Please review the enclosed documents carefully and be sure that you understand and fully implement all the conditions incorporated into the licenses. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region I Office, Licensing Assistance Team, (610) 337-5239, so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14).
