LICENSEE:




10 CFR 40.53(c)(1) requires the licensee to file a report for the transfer of items containing source material. The report must include the description of each type of product, model number(s), total quantity, and the number of units of each type of product transferred. The report is to be submitted on or before January 31 of each year for the period covering the preceding calendar year.

Contrary to the above, the licensee failed to file a report with the NRC which includes a description or identification of the type and quantity of each product transferred the radionuclide in each type of product and model number of units transferred, and the total quantity of each radionuclide transferred. Specifically, the licensee had not filed a report covering the period from September 15, 2014 through December 31, 2014, on or before January 31, 2015.

The licensee committed to filing the required report for the period noted above within 30 days of the inspection date. The licensee's corrective actions will include determining the description or identification of the type and quantity of each product transferred, the radionuclide, and the total number of units transferred or distributed, compiling the required information, producing the reports and committed to submitting a timely report to the NRC every year as required.

Licensee's Statement of Corrective Actions for Item 4, above.

I hereby state that, within 30 days, the actions described by me to the inspector will be taken to correct the violations identified. This statement of corrective actions is made in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.201 (corrective steps already taken, corrective steps which will be taken, date when full compliance will be achieved).
