- 1) With regard to Item 5 of your application dated 04/20/15, please clarify the use of PET materials at your facility.

Northern Shared Medical is a mobile PET company which travels to SSM St Clare Health Center on Wednesday mornings from 08:00am-12:00pm and Friday afternoons from 1:00pm-5:00pm. It is the responsibility of Northern Shared Medical for receiving and disposal of all radiopharmaceuticals. (Copy of Northern Shared Medical NRC license is included.)

- 2) With regard to Item 5 of your application dated 04/20/15, please provide a *total* possession limit for all 35.300 materials. We no longer specify iodine-131 with a separate possession limit.

Total possession limit for 35.300 materials is 2 Curies.

- 3) With regard to Item 7 of your application dated 04/20/15, please provide additional information regarding 3 physicians requested to be authorized users for 35.100 and 35.200: Robert Fischer, M.D., Noaman Siddiqi, M.D. and John Stephens, M.D. These individuals are not currently (or previously) listed on your license and no supporting documentation for their training and experience was included in the application.

At this time, please delete names Robert Fischer, M.D. and Noaman Siddiqi, M.D.

Please include John Joseph Stephens, M.D. for 10 CFR 35.100, 35.200, 35.300 (limited to the oral administration of sodium iodide I-131) who is on NRC license #24-11858-01.

MATERIALS LICENSE
