
Mr. Parker:

Please allow this letter to serve as a response to your request for additional information in support of the amendment request of Margaret Mary Community Hospital, Materials License, Number 13-26494-01. Margaret Mary Community Hospital is changing the license name to Margaret Mary Health. You requested we provide responses to Appendix F of NUREG 1556, Volume 15. Below are our responses in the order they are listed in Appendix F.

1. The hospital has legally changed its name but there has been no transfer of control. Additionally, the mailing address of the hospital will remain as currently listed on the license.
2. There are no changes in personnel or duties in regards to the licensed program.
3. There are no changes in the organization, location, facilities, equipment or procedures, as related to the licensed program.
4. The surveillance program currently consists of daily radiation level surveys and weekly contamination surveys. There will be no change to the surveillance program following the name change.
5. We confirm that all records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the facility will continue to be maintained by the licensee following the name change.
6. We confirm that we will continue to abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, and commitments following the name change.
