This letter documents the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff's plan to perform an inspection of Canberra Industries to review implementation of your quality assurance program in accordance with Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 50, Appendix B and 10 CFR Part 21. Specifically, the quality assurance program will be reviewed as it pertains to Canberra Industries' design, fabrication, testing, and commercial grade dedication of radiation monitoring equipment supplied to operating nuclear power plants. As discussed by conference call on September 11, 2015, the inspectors plan to arrive at your Meriden, CT, facility, on November 2, 2015, and will conduct the inspection through Friday, November 6, 2015. Subsequent to the inspection, a report will be issued and transmitted to you via letter.
