Attached is a copy of the proposed revision to the North Dakota Radiological Health Rules as identified below. Because North Dakota adopts the NRC rules by reference, the attachments reflect the changes being made to those sections of the rules that have been previously adopted. The changes as tracked in the attachments correspond to the following NRC regulations. Chapter 33-10-22, which incorporates Part 37, is a new section to the North Dakota Radiological Health Rules.
