Background

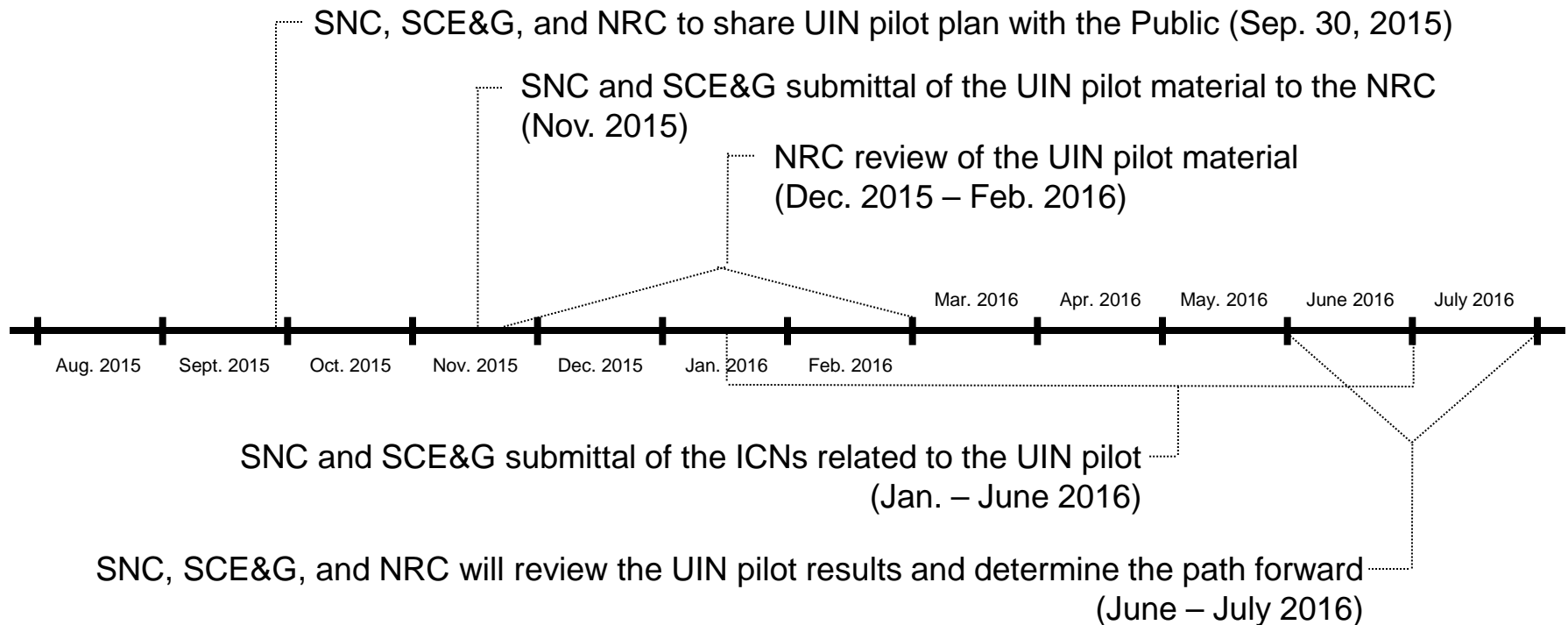
- SNC identified a potential opportunity to submit the UIN early
- SCANA and SNC discussed the potential benefits and risks of such an effort, and approached the NRC about testing the benefit of an early UIN submittal
- NRC, SNC and SCANA agreed that a pilot would be best path forward to determine the benefit of an early UIN

Goals of the Pilot Early UIN

- Determine if and how much efficiency is gained in the NRC Staff's UIN and ICN review process by an early UIN submittal
- Exercise the program the NRC will put into place to review UINs and subsequent ICNs
- Exercise the Licensees procedures/programs for development of the UIN
- Determine how changes will be tracked internally between the UIN and subsequent ICN submittal

UIN Pilot Timeline

- ~20 ITAAC identified for the Pilot



Potential Benefits of an Early UIN

- Reduce the NRC peak workload during the surge by decreasing ICN acceptance review time
- Increase confidence in NRC acceptance of submitted ICNs for which they have reviewed the UIN
- Opportunity to write and refine determination bases early, decreasing ICN and determination report writing time in the future
- Identify potential issues with ITAAC closure early
