I am responding to your letter dated August 25, 2015, which requested that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) approve a new Truck Route designated as No. 251 for transporting spent nuclear fuel from North Anna Power Station (NAPS), Mineral, VA to Oak Ridge National Laboratory (ORNL), Oak Ridge, TN.

The NRC has reviewed your application and concluded that the information satisfies the requirements of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 73.37. This letter constitutes approval of Truck Route No. 251 which will expire October 31, 2020. The NRC expects your periodic review and update of the emergency phone numbers associated with this route. Changes to emergency contact numbers do not qualify as a route deviation or change.
