To Whom it May Concern,

In response to the request for additional information concerning application for a license amendment, control 588320, Wheeling Jesuit University submits this letter of explanation with support materials.

The authorization for 10 CFR 31.11 from September 5, 1979 through July 21, 2005 was reviewed and records searched that revealed only records for isotopes with half-lives less than 120 days. I-125 and I-131 were the only notable receipts. No unsealed materials were ever used that were greater than 120 day half life. No surveys were necessary to close out the space.

The same thorough records review and search revealed that there were no previous need to submit records pursuant to 10 CFR 30.35 (g), 30.36 (k)(4), and 30.51.

The leak tests previously included were those of the known material on campus that was recently disposed of. There were no other sources identified that were leaking or in need of testing and not included both past and present.

Our Nuclear Medicine Technology program was both successful and diligent in their responsibilities to our campus and the standards and guidelines set by the NRC.
