SUBJECT: NRC APPROVAL OF PLUS LLC REQUEST FOR WITHHOLDING
INFORMATION FROM PUBLIC DISCLOSURE

Dear Mr. Gupta:

Plus, LLC submitted an affidavit dated September 21, 2015, executed by Idalia Navarro, requesting that the content of the application date September 21, 2015 and its attachments, be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.390. The contents of the documents contains specifically details on product composition and design is not available from any other public sources.

The affidavit states that Plus LLC is requesting to withhold proprietary information by relying on the exemption set forth in NRC Regulations 10 CFR 2.390(a)(4). This information is Plus LLC owned information that falls under "Trade Secrets, Commercial, Proprietary/Privileged and confidential Information." The content is consider proprietary for the following reasons: (1) The information is confidential information owned by Morgan Advanced Materials, (2) The information will allow a competitor to understand Plus LLC techniques and geometry, and the Quality Control procedures of Plus LLC Production/Manufacturing business.

We have reviewed your application and the material in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.390 and, on the basis of your statements, have determined that the submitted information sought to be withheld contains proprietary commercial information and should be withheld from public disclosure.

Therefore, Plus LLC information submitted in license application request dated September 21, 2015, will be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.390(b)(5) and Section 103(b) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended. Withholding from public inspection shall not affect the right, if any, of persons properly and directly concerned to inspect the documents.

If the basis for withholding this information from public inspection should change in the future such that the information could then be made available for public inspection, you should promptly notify the NRC. You also should understand that the NRC may have cause to review this determination in the future, for example, if the scope of a Freedom of Information Act request includes your information. In all review situations, if the NRC makes a determination adverse to the above, you will be notified of the date of public disclosure, in advance which will be a reasonable time thereafter.
