On behalf of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), I am writing to thank you for your letter dated September 22, 2015, which provided the NRC staff with the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards (ACRS) summary conclusions and recommendations regarding SECY-15-0085, "Evaluation of the Containment Protection and Release Reduction for Mark I and Mark II Boiling Water Reactors Rulemaking Activities," and the staff document "Draft Regulatory Basis for Containment Protection and Release Reduction for Mark I and Mark II Boiling Water Reactors (10 CFR Part 50)." The staff benefited from the many interactions with the ACRS and its valuable insights provided on the issues discussed in these documents. The ACRS' conclusions regarding the safety benefits already achieved via NRC Orders reinforce the Commission's direction to the staff to discontinue the rulemaking and to implement the existing Order (EA-13-109) without additional regulatory actions.
