Dear Mr. Moore:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 07 to your NRC Materials License No. 21-24504-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold font**.

In letter dated July 2, 2015, you contacted the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate NRC Materials License No. 21-24504-01 for City of Mt. Pleasant. The aforementioned letter included NRC Form 314, "Certificate of Disposition of Materials," supporting the decommissioning of your location at 1303 N. Franklin Street, Mt. Pleasant, Michigan.

The NRC staff has reviewed all of this information, including your final status surveys. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your facility and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.

Based on these conclusions, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facility at 1303 N. Franklin Street, Mt. Pleasant, Michigan, is suitable for unrestricted use and NRC License No. 21-24504-01 is hereby terminated.


