PURPOSE: The purpose of this meeting is to discuss draft preliminary changes from
the Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR)
Section 50.46c proposed rule (Agencywide Documents Access and
Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML12283A174) to the
draft final rule.

This meeting will inform stakeholders of the draft preliminary changes to
the 10 CFR 50.46c rule since it was published for comment, in order to
prepare for an Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards meeting in
November 2015. In addition, the attendees will discuss draft preliminary
implementation, per the Cumulative Effects of Regulation process. In
order to facilitate this discussion, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory
Commission (NRC) will be providing a draft, preliminary version of the
10 CFR 50.46c rule package on regulations.gov, Docket ID NRC-2008-
0332 on or around October 13, 2015. Please note that the preliminary
draft documents have not received NRC management review and
approval and are thus pre-decisional and subject to change. The NRC
is NOT providing an opportunity for submission of written public
comments in connection with these meetings.
