Dear Ms. Cook:

This is in response to your email dated October 8, 2015 requesting additional information supporting our request for license renewal.

1. I have attached a copy of the RSO Delegation of Authority which was signed in 2013.
2. The long term storage area is the area which is labeled "Waste Room" in Figure 1.
3. For Xofigo (Ra-223), we receive unit doses. The dose calibrator is calibrated for Ra-223 using a NIST traceable Ra-223 standard which was provided by the manufacturer. Each unit dose is measured using the dose calibrator and pre-determined Ra-223 setting. The dose calibrator is tested according to nationally recognized standards (daily constancy, quarterly linearity, annual accuracy, and geometry initially and after repair).
4. We are not using PET radionuclides.

Subject: Delegation of Authority to Radiation Safety Officer

You, Ronald Frick, M.S., CHP, DABR, have been appointed Radiation Safety Officer for Straub Clinic & Hospital, and are responsible for ensuring the safe use of radiation. You are responsible for managing the radiation protection program; identifying radiation protection problems; initiating, recommending, or providing corrective actions; verifying implementation of corrective actions; stopping unsafe activities; and ensuring compliance with regulations. You are hereby delegated the authority necessary to meet those responsibilities, including prohibiting the use of byproduct material by employees who do not meet the necessary requirements and shutting down operations where justified by radiation safety. You are required to notify management if staff do not cooperate and do not address radiation safety issues. In addition, you are free to raise issues with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission at any time.


