This letter documents the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff's plan to perform an inspection of Sulzer Pumps (US) Inc. to review implementation of your quality assurance program in accordance with Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 50, Appendix B and 10 CFR Part 21. Specifically, the quality assurance program and Part 21 implementation, will be reviewed as they pertain to Sulzer Pumps (US) Inc. design, commercial grade dedication and manufacturing of safety related pumps to operating nuclear power plants. As discussed through conference call on October 15, 2015, the inspectors plan to arrive at the Chattanooga, TN facility, on Monday, November 16, 2015, and will conduct the inspection through Friday, November 20, 2015.
