SUBJECT: Supporting Regulatory Document for Signature Authority on Financial Assurance Documents

1. Reference. Telephone conversation between Mr. Dennis Lawyer, Nuclear Regulatory Commission, and Scott Goodison, Radiation Safety Officer, Army Public Health Center, 24 September 2015, Subject as Above.
2. In accordance with Reference 1 above, we are providing the regulatory authority to indicate that I am the appropriate person to sign financial assurance documents for decommissioning for Army Public Health Center facilities.
3. The Army Public Health Center does not have a military Commander assigned. I exercise senior manager authority in accordance with AR 600-20, which we are providing as enclosure 1. The following paragraphs apply:
 - a. Paragraph 1-5a: "A civilian, other than the President as Commander-in-Chief, may not exercise Command. However, a civilian may be designated to exercise general supervision over an Army installation or activity."
 - b. Paragraph 2-5b(4)(a)2: Referring to the Senior Commander (SC), "Can, in rare cases, be a HQDA-appointed civilian versus a uniformed SC, who will assume the SC roles and responsibilities with the exception of UCMJ and command authority. In these instances, the individual will be referred to as the senior manager."
