## General Comment

"Adequate protection of public health and safety continues to be ensured. " NOTHING COULD BE FARTHER FROM THE TRUTH ON THIS RULE.

These casks are only 1/2 inch thick, and do not last more than 100 years. They are known to crack after 20 years, and are unmovable after a very short period of time. That means that they are directly the opposite of this statement: " Adequate protection of public health and safety continues to be ensured."

The NRC cannot state they are concerned about public health and safety while it continues to approve putting nuclear waste into casts that are so thin. In Europe, they put their waste in casts that are at least 18 inches thick, and then they build a structure around it to keep the leaking radiation from escaping.

The NRC does not require this, in fact, the NRC has so little regard for human health, they now allow nuclear power licensees to store their waste in casts that next to the plants, in the open, causing a more severe threat to terrorism and other attacks, while being a ticking time bombs as they wait for these casts to start cracking and leaking into the groundwater, as is happening at Hanford.

The NRC has become a rubber stamp for the nuclear industry. As Senator Barbara Boxer stated "The NRC did not see an extension of license request they did not like" and have approved without regard to human health any request the nuclear industry makes of it.
