Dear Sir or Madam,

As provided under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), I request information pertaining to Kenneth A. Spencer in his capacity of "President", CEO, Owner/Operator, GM etc and or his affiliated companies/entities known as; the former Jayhawk Ordnance Works, former Military Chemical Works, former Spencer Chemical Co, also known as the "Galena sub-site" (and information listed under any other names regarding southeast Kansas or southwest Missouri, including; radioactive and or toxic chemicals, radioactive and or toxic waste burial sites, radioactive waste storage containers, radioactive settling ponds/"settling basins" and locations used by and or radioactive chemicals released from the entities just listed) regarding southeast Kansas and southwest Missouri. These entities; Kenneth A. Spencer, their employees, military personnel, Jayhawk, Spencer Chemical, Military Chemical and Gulf Oil Co. will now be referred to as one in the same, as "KJSMG" located, primarily, in southeast Kansas.

Please provide me with the following documents:

- All applications granted for nuclear licenses to KJSMG and what the nuclear/radioactive elements were and their quantity.
- 1st known date of use of nuclear/radioactive elements at KJSMG
- All exposures/releases to air, water, land or otherwise... at or by KJSMG in southeast KS and or southwest MO and the levels recorded/reported.
- All documents pertaining to radiation and the "settling basin(s)" and or "waste tanks", the definition and difference of each term.
- All documents concerning the basins and tanks location(s), amount of wastes, the date the settling basin began being used, when it stopped being used and what happened to this pond?
- All documentation of the settling pond(s)/basin(s) being lined or unlined and if it/they 'leached' into the aquifer(s) and or spilled/overflowed;
 - where these waste tanks were stored, buried or otherwise 'decommissioned'.
 - and when the waste tanks were stored, buried or otherwise 'decommissioned', were they later moved to another location, and if so, where and when.
- The first recorded radioactive levels in area aquifers (specifically near "Well 13" (USGS) in or near Galena of southeast KS/southwest MO above 2.6 pCi/l and then all recorded/reported radiation levels found in the aquifer(s) connected to (and or aquifers that may be affected by) KJSMG surface waters and or leaching, uranium dusts/nuclear dusts from settling ponds/settling basins and or hoods or ventilation systems and at what radiation levels they were recorded.
- All water reports from 1940 to present (10/19/2015) showing radiation levels and or pesticides, chemicals, oils that are not recycled oils


- A list of all types of radiation, radioisotopes, nuclear elements ever tested for and ever discovered at or near or contaminated by KJSMG in southeast KS and or southwest MO.
- A complete list of all chemicals or pesticides used or manufactured or stored by KJSMG
- A complete list of all chemicals or pesticides 'enhanced' with stereo-isotopes; when and where they were used, made or stored on the KJSMG site, what amount was used, made or stored, and the disposition of these chemicals/pesticides and of their waste by-products, both on or off site.
- All radiation levels of products, building materials and processes that were decommissioned and their initial disposition and any removal and relocation of any radioactive materials.
- All documents pertaining to revocation of nuclear licenses and or reprimands and or fines paid and or warning notices to the KJSMG site from 1940-present.
- Any and all radiation releases by KJSMG or other entities during mining, digging, exploration in southeast Kansas or southwest Missouri that were found and presumed/known to be from KJSMG burying the wastes, unbeknownst to anyone.

Kerr-McGee removed much of the equipment and products from KJSMG ca. September 1962 to their site in Oklahoma. Please provide me with any and all records of radioactive releases/exposures/reportings from Kerr-McGee employees, inspectors, or otherwise... during the AEC's or any other entities' initial inspections/start-up inspections of the Kerr-McGee site/location in Oklahoma.
