NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Stein:

On September 21, 2015, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) cited Peak Laboratories for failure to meet the conditions found in your NRC License 49-29337-01. Inspection Report 030-37954/2015-001 with enclosed Notice of Violation (ML15260B416), required you to respond in writing within 30 days. You responded by letter received on October 23, 2015 (ML15302A390), and submitted an amendment request dated July 31, 2015 (ML15261A414).

After reviewing the information you provided in your response to the Notice of Violation, we have concluded that your completed and proposed actions appear to adequately address the regulatory noncompliance described in the Notice of Violation. We will review your implementation of these corrective actions during a future inspection to determine whether full compliance has been restored and whether compliance will be maintained.
