Enclosed is an application, dated October 16, 2015, received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission from Edlow International Company, requesting amendment No. 01 to its existing license, XSNM3763. The license presently authorizes the export of low-enriched uranium to Australia for fuel and medical isotope production at the OPAL reactor.

The purpose of the amendment is to: 1) include an additional intermediate consignee, and 2) include an additional U.S. party to the export.
