ITEM 8: TRAINING FOR INDIVIDUALS WORKING IN OR FREQUENTING RESTRICTED AREAS

Before using licensed materials, authorized users will have successfully completed one of the training courses described in "Criteria" in the section entitled "Training for Individuals Working in or Frequenting Restricted Areas" in NUREG - 1556, Vol. 1, Rev. 2, "Consolidated Guidance about Materials Licenses: Program - Specific Guidance about Portable Gauge Licenses".

ITEM 10.2: RADIATION SAFETY PROGRAM - SURVEY INSTRUMENTS

We will either possess and use, or have access to and use, a radiation survey meter that meets the criteria in the section titled "Radiation Safety Program-Instruments" in NUREG - 1556, Vol. 1, Rev. 2, "Consolidated Guidance about Materials Licenses: Program - Specific Guidance about Portable Gauge Licenses", in the event of an incident.

ITEM 10.3: RADIATION SAFETY PROGRAM – MATERIAL RECEIPT AND ACCOUNTABILITY

Physical inventories will be conducted at intervals not to exceed 6 months, to account for all sealed sources and devices received and possessed under the license.

ITEM 10.4: RADIATION SAFETY PROGRAM – OCCUPATIONAL DOSIMETRY

We will provide dosimetry processed and evaluated by an NVLAP - approved processor that is exchanged at a frequency recommended by the processor.

ITEM 10.6: RADIATION SAFETY PROGRAM – OPERATING, EMERGENCY, AND SECURITY PROCEDURES

We will implement and maintain the operating and emergency procedures in Appendix G of NUREG - 1556, Vol. 1, Rev. 2, "Consolidated Guidance about Materials Licenses: Program - Specific Guidance about Portable Gauge Licenses", and will develop, implement and maintain security procedures using information in Appendix G. Copies of these procedures will be provided to all gauge users and at each job site.

ITEM 10.7: RADIATION SAFETY PROGRAM – LEAK TESTS

Leak tests will be performed at intervals approved by the NRC or an Agreement State and specified in the SSD registration certificate. Leak tests will be performed by an organization licensed by the NRC or an Agreement State to provide leak testing services to other licensees or using a leak test kit supplied by an organization licensed by the NRC or an Agreement State to provide leak test kits to other licensees and according to the kit supplier's instructions.

ITEM 10.8: RADIATION SAFETY PROGRAM – MAINTENANCE

Routine Cleaning and Lubrication

We will implement and maintain procedures for routine maintenance of our gauges according to each manufacturer's recommendations and instructions.

Nonroutine Maintenance

We will send the gauge to the manufacturer or other person authorized by the NRC or an Agreement State to perform nonroutine maintenance or repair operations that require detaching the source or source rod from the gauge.
