

Upon review of the above-mentioned annual report, I make the following comments.

The following comments should be address in next year's (2015-2016) annual report.

It is my recommendation to Cameco that the following tables could be represented by an executive summary with the data loaded to a CD. Since this is a new process, it may take some trial and error to get it worked out but it should fit into the next phase of LQD's plan to work toward electronic reporting.

- ※ Table II-F.1 TOPSOIL STOCKPILE SUMMARY. The executive summary could include "Total Estimated Volume" on hand to date, the "Total Estimated Volume" used, and a reference to a CD showing all of the current data in a spreadsheet format.
- ※ Table II-F.2 ACREAGE AFFECTED SUMMARY. The executive summary could include wording such as "Total Affected Acres "Prior to 1987 to 201?" and the total acres. A reference to a CD showing all of the current data in a spreadsheet format.
- ※ Table II-H.1 Stimulation of Class III Wells. The executive summary could include total number of wells stimulated for the report period and a reference to a CD showing all of the current data in a spreadsheet format.
- ※ Table IV-B.1 Delineation Holes Drilled 201?-201? Annual Report Period. The executive summary could include total number of wells drilled, which could be broken out by Private, State and Federal. A reference to a CD showing all of the current data in a spreadsheet format.

- Platt 1-14, Mine Unit 9, SE, SE, Section 7. Please remember to revise the permit boundary when the boundary changes are approved to include the Monitor Well Ring.
- Please remember to revise the entire permit boundary to reflect all approved boundary changes.

Please keep in mind that your annual report is a public document and can be viewed by anyone. As you know, it could be sent to the NRC, BLM or other federal agencies that may have jurisdiction in or around your mine site. Anything you can do to reduce confusion is a winning move on your part.
