SHINE MEDICAL TECHNOLOGIES, INC. COMMENT ON THE DRAFT REGULATORY ISSUE SUMMARY (RIS), RIS 2015-XX, "REVIEW AND SUBMISSION OF UPDATES TO FINAL SAFETY ANALYSIS REPORTS, EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS DOCUMENTS, AND FIRE PROTECTION DOCUMENTS" (NRC-2015-0226)

Comment on the Draft Regulatory Issue Summary

SHINE does not clearly understand whether or not the guidance provided in the Draft Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) 2015-XX, "Review and Submission of Updates to Final Safety Analysis Reports, Emergency Preparedness Documents, and Fire Protection Documents," is intended to supersede portions of the guidance provided in RIS 2005-31 (Reference 1) for screening of Emergency Preparedness and Fire Protection-related documents being submitted to the NRC.

Section 2.C of Attachment 2 to RIS 2005-31 provides Emergency Planning/Fire Protection Information criteria to be used in the screening of documents for submittal to the NRC for security-related information. It appears as if the guidance provided in Draft RIS 2015-XX is intended to replace the screening criteria provided in Section 2.C of Attachment 2 to RIS 2005-31, which states, in part, "Withhold information related to emergency planning, emergency response, and fire protection." However, Draft RIS 2015-XX does not state which portions of RIS 2005-31 it is intended to supersede.

Recommend Draft RIS 2015-XX explicitly state which section(s) of the RIS 2005-31 guidance it is intended to supersede. In addition, Draft RIS 2015-XX should acknowledge that the remaining portions of RIS 2005-31 should be followed regarding the control of security-related sensitive unclassified non-safeguards information handled by individuals, firms, and entities subject to NRC regulation of the use of source, byproduct, and special nuclear material.
