This letter is sent in support of Alexion Pharmaceuticals request to amend Radioactive Materials License No. 06-28799-01; specifically in response to your request for additional information regarding my experience with specific radioactive materials and request to transfer the role of Radiation Safety Officer.

I have managed radiation safety programs as an institutional official for 17 years and have developed and overseen the radioactive materials programs for pharmaceutical drug metabolism, bioanalytical studies, analytical chemistry and aerospace defense programs, including radioactive material used in marking and identification of pharmaceutical drug substances, sealed source analytical equipment and X-Ray generating equipment for inspection and X-Ray crystallography.. My Radio Isotope experiences include working with and overseeing safety programs involving the Hydrogen 3 (5 mCi), Carbon 14 (5 mCi), Barium 133 (40 mCi, sealed source), and Nickle 63 (60 mCi, sealed source) at Forest Laboratories Inc. (now Allergan PLC.).
