The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), Philadelphia District, as a cooperating agency, have completed the final environmental impact statement (EIS) for an early site permit (ESP) at the PSEG site, located in Lower Alloways Creek Township, Salem County, New Jersey, pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, as amended. A copy of the final EIS, NUREG-2168, "*Environmental Impact Statement for an Early Site Permit (ESP) at the PSEG Site, Final Report*," is included with this letter for your information.

A notice of availability of the final EIS is anticipated to be published by the NRC on November 20, 2015, in the *Federal Register*.
