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Dear Mr. Reber,

I am working with Max Maschewske, our Radiation Safety Officer, regarding the Material Transfer Report revision. Before we finalize the revisions I wanted to make sure we are correct in citing 10CFR 30.14. We are using Tritium as a tracer in engine oil to determine oil consumption. The transfers we make are engine and engine components for two purposes;

1/ the vast majority is for final disposition of the test engines to a metal recycler as scrap (after they have met all the criteria for transfer per our License) and 2/ transfer of engine parts to other facilities within our company for evaluation and inspection, again after they have met our License criteria. We do not produce a product containing byproduct material for sale or use by the public and the components have only come in contact with the engine oil, which contains the Tritium. Thank you for your assistance.
