Dear Mr. Reigner,

I've reviewed your exempt distribution report dated September 29, 2015, for transfers in 2014. (ML15300A086)

Please revise and resubmit your report as follows:

1. 10 CFR 40.53 (c)(2) requires that your report must indicate that the products are transferred for use under 10 CFR 40.13(c), giving the specific paragraph designation, or equivalent regulations of an Agreement State. Your report states that your products were transferred for use under 10 CFR 40.13(c)(iii); however, the correct regulatory reference is 10 CFR 40.13(c)(1)(iii) and your revised report should include this regulatory reference.
2. 40.53 (c)(3)(iii) requires that your report must include the number of units of each type of product transferred by model number, if applicable. While your report does indicate the weight of thorium that was transferred by model number, you did not include the number of units of each type of product transferred by model number, if applicable. In the revision of your report, please include this information.

Further information about the requirements that apply to annual reports of exempt distribution can be found in the attached Regulatory Issue Summary.
